#### Seniors Ideas

### Name that Person

Have a number of seniors line up facing the audience at the front of the room. Have name tags for each of the seniors. Challenge the girls to put the correct name tag on the correct senior. Then switch it the other way around.

When the seniors are at the front, have the girls put them in age from the youngest to the oldest. It can be a lot of fun as long as you choose people that will not be offended too easily.

If you have a number of mom/daughter combinations, have the seniors put the correct daughter with the correct mom.

## Signature Game

On the next page there is a printable sheet to give to the girls. The girls go around with this paper and ask the seniors questions such as:

- Were you born in this country?
- Did you come by plane or boat?
- What was the name of the boat?
- What did you do for a job for most of your life?
- Any hobbies or talents?

#### Relay Race

Set up four tables, one in each corner of the Fellowship Hall. Make 2 - 4 teams of girls with 2 - 4 seniors sitting at the station tables.

Station #1: Put on a pair of sunglasses, work socks, hat and scarf.

Station #2: Put on oven mitts and with two forks unwrap a present, one layer only. Then take off the hat and sunglasses.

Station #3: Here the senior will hold a doll and the girl will diaper the doll. Use cloth diapers or disposables without using their hands. Take off the work socks and put them on the doll.

Station #4: The senior holds a large needle and the girl must thread it. Leave the scarf here. Then run to station #1 and tag the next girl. She runs to station #4 and does everything in the opposite order.
